

Portsmouth Outpatient Campus

- Since opening in 2016, the Portsmouth Outpatient Center has been successful in creating a differentiated care experience with a patientcentered, service line focus and collaborative approach to program development with Massachusetts General Hospital.
- 97,000 sq/ft in three buildings
- Services include primary care, comprehensive specialty care, lab, and imaging. The site also offers a satellite of the Mass General Cancer Center, which offers medical and radiation oncology.





Overview of Behavioral Health Services

Integrated Behavioral Health Services:

- Clinicians provide consultation, triage and skills-based brief intervention within primary care, OB and Bariatric practices
 Both embedded and non-embedded sites
- eConsults psychiatric medication support for Nurse Practitioners and Psychiatrists at Great Bay Mental Health

Great Bay Mental Health:

- Outpatient mental health practice
- Counselors provide clinical assessment and a combination of short-term and longer-term treatment
- Psychiatric Nurse Practitioners and Psychiatrists provide consultation, assessment, and treatment for medication management
- Services to children, families, adults, couples who are Wentworth Health Partners primary care patients
- Provide specialty services to WDH Cancer Center, and work collaboratively with Neurology neuropsychologists

Inpatient Consultation:

- Psychiatric Nurse Practitioners and Psychiatrists from Great Bay Mental Health provide consultation and liaison service
- BHS Crisis Team Clinicians provide assessment, disposition planning, and coordination of care

Emergency Department:

- Psychiatric Nurse Practitioners and Psychiatrists from Great Bay Mental Health provide consultation, assessment, and treatment for medication management
- WDH Behavioral Health Crisis Team Clinicians provide assessment, disposition planning, and coordination of care
- Community Mental Health Center provides telehealth assessments during after hours timeframe when WDH Behavioral Health Crisis Team Clinicians are not working
- Pod of 5 psychiatric-safe patient rooms to provide ongoing care of behavioral health patients in a safer and more focused manner

Peer Recovery Support:


• Substance Use Disorder peer recovery coaches provide support, advocacy and resource connection to patients at WDH and follow-up in the community


The Doorway:

- NH Opioid Response Grant, hub and spokes model serving Stafford County & a more than ½ of Rockingham County
- Clinicians and care coordinators provide substance use disorder assessment, referrals to services, case management, and crisis management
- A second location, in Dover, opened July 2023 to provide medications for opioid and alcohol use disorders
